### Town of Saranac Foundation of CVPH Partner Update Saranac River Trail Spur May 20, 2019

The NYS Health Foundation has solicited an application from the Foundation of CVPH to complete the last two spurs of the Saranac River Trail Greenway. The Towns of Saranac and Schuyler Falls each have an identified spur in their Townships. The Town of Saranac spur is located along Route 3, in an area identified as the Town Green. This is considered an extension of the Pickets Corner Recreation Park. The Schuyler Falls spur is to be located on River Street in the Hamlet of Morrisonville.

Funding Source: NYS Health Foundation

Local Public/Private Partner: Foundation of CVPH

Award Amount \$200,000

Award Operational Period: July 1, 2019 - June 30, 2021

Portion Designated for the Town of Saranac: \$45,000 This includes a mix of award funds/Clinton County Tobacco Settlement Funds and remaining LaPierre Lane Spur community donations.

Pending Resolution and public/private partnership agreement Exhibit A can be changed to allow additional funds to be expended if they become available.

Work Period: Year Two July 1, 2020 - June 30, 2021

#### Spur Work to be Completed .

- Approximately a .5 mile ADA Compliant trail around the Town Green roadways. Will be
  paved/have trail marker signage/lined along roadway. If funds allow it is the intention of the
  Foundation of CVPH to also provided LED crosswalk style lights/marking that meet Federal
  Standards. It will include the County and Town owned roads: Chazy Lake Road/Ganong
  Drive/Sharkey Lane/McCutchen Road,
- Approximately 450 feet of Adirondack style barrier designed to discourage children/adults from
  entering area from Rt. 3 roadway. Will be comprised of a mix of large and small stones/cedar
  fencing, will be approximately 4 feet wide, will be slightly raised and have ground barrier to
  reduce weeds/grass, and be slightly curved to be aesthetically pleasing and follow the roadway. All
  NYS DOT setbacks will be followed.
- · Kiosk identifying community partners/SRTG map/Town of Saranac spur highlighted, etc.

WHEREAS, the Mountain Lions SnowSled Club (hereafter the "Club") is an IRS Code 501-(c)3 non-profit organization dedicated to the enjoyment and advancement of the sport of snowmobiling, and is seeking to replace its aging trail grooming equipment to provide a more enjoyable trail riding experience; and

WHEREAS, the Club seeks apply for and be awarded a Recreational Trails Program funding Grant; and

WHEREAS, the current Trail Grooming equipment is antiquated, unreliable, and costly to maintain in both replacement parts and volunteer labor hours; and

WHEREAS, absent a replacement machine, the club will be unlikely to continue to provide Trail Grooming functions in the next year or two; and

WHEREAS, the planned replacement equipment will be usable during the summer months to allow trail bed maintenance in preparation for the winter season; and

WHEREAS, the Recreational Trails Program has specific provisions for Trail Grooming equipment procurement; and
